Located in Green Lake, Wisconsin, the Golf Courses of Lawsonia is a public 36-hole destination property offering two golf courses - the Links and Woodlands. Lawsonia's two contrasting layouts host over 40,000 rounds annually including numerous WPGA and WSGA tournament events. William Langford and Theodore Moreau's renowned Scottish-inspired Links course is currently ranked #79 on Golf Magazine's 2022-23 list of Top 100 Courses in the U.S. and is annually ranked as one of the best courses in the state. DESCRIPTION OF CLUB

Located in Wisconsin Dells, WI, Trappers Turn Golf Club offers 27 holes of championship golf and a 12 hole Par-3 course. The spring of 1991 marked the birth of Trappers Turn Golf Club. Twotime U.S. Open Champion Andy North and renowned golf course designer Roger Packard have created what many consider the ultimate golf course. North and Packard masterfully molded a layout to compliment the surrounding land features, in an area carved by glaciers. The beauty of the Wisconsin Dells countryside provides a beautiful backdrop to a uniquely challenging and scenic golf design.

In 1998, construction began on the Arbor nine as well as reconstruction of the first three holes of the original 18 layout. Trappers Turn Golf Club was proud to present the Lake, Canyon, and Arbor nines in 2000. The 27 hole facility allows guests to choose between Scottish flair, traditional tree-lined fairways and holes compatible with the natural canyon beauty.

In the fall of 2019, construction of 12 North began and continued through 2020. Once again Andy North came forth and teamed up with Craig Haltom from Oliphant Haltom Golf and designed and constructed a one-of-a-kind Par-3 course with holes ranging from 50-120 yards.

Located in The Pocono Mountains, PA, Pocono Manor Golf Course is a historic 1910s golf course combining the work of two famous and influential golf course designers from the early 20th century. In 1912 the original 9 hole track opened featuring a Donald Ross design. William Flynn designed an additional 10 holes on the property and the course opened the current 18 hole routing in the early 1920s.

For over 100 years the facility has hosted golfers ranging from vacationers and local enthusiasts to touring professionals. Art Wall Jr. famously won the 1959 Masters along with numerous other professional tournaments while playing as Pocono Manor's touring professional through the 1950s, 60s and 70s. He and his son Greg Wall have hosted outings at Pocono Manor featuring tour professionals, Arnold Palmer, Sam Snead, and Tommy Bolt among many others. In recent years OGM has revitalized course conditions and made impactful improvements including green rebuilds and expansions and tree work and drainage projects.

Currently offering the best golf conditions in its storied history, Pocono Manor Golf Course is a regional destination for golf history lovers and players of all abilities.
